TESTING PROBLEMS & SUCCESS STRATEGIES

POSSIBLE SOLUTION

I studied, but I didn't study what was on the test

Identification of important, difficult, or unfamiliar material

- 1. Regular class and study group attendance
- 2. Text clues/summaries & chapter questions
- 3. Visit Professor

I can't figure out what the Professor &/or book is talking about

Comprehension – Apply METHODS to help understanding

- 1. Preview/outline/question technique
- 2. Read text before class
- 3. Use SQ3(4)R/other comprehension technique

I just can't remember what I read.

Retention - Review, Review, Review

- 1. Review notes for 10 minutes within 24
- 2. Review again within 2 days
- 3. Weekly 1 hour review session

I know the information but I can't think of it on the test.

Retrieval of knowledge

- Predict test contents
- 2. Organize notes into meaningful groups
- 3. Multi-sensory study
- 4. Make reading & studying an active process

I know the information but I can't write a good essay question or discuss it in class.

Utilization of knowledge

- 1. Predict questions & prepare answers
- 2. Prepare for class discussion

I can't answer multiple choice questions.

Identification, Comprehension Retrieval, Over-analysis

- Practice by predicting questions and writing out the answers (also do with a buddy).
- 2. Read question and write answer on a separate sheet of paper before looking at the choices.
- 3. Rule out obviously wrong choices.
- 4. You may be reading too much into the wording of the answers. If so, don't overanalyze MC questions
- 5. If you're confused, leave the questions and come back to it.
