

Change from Resident to Commuter Status

A commuter is defined as a student who lives and sleeps at same address of an approved family member.

All Houghton College students are required to live in a college residence unless commuting from home, or specifically exempted. If a student has lived on campus or in a Family Living Exemption for at least one semester and plans to change to commuter status, this form must be filled out by both the student and an approved family member.
