U.S. immigration regulations require all students in F-1 status to complete their program by the completion date noted in item #5 of their I-20. In order to qualify for a program extension the student must have lawfully maintained F-1 status and must be able to demonstrate that the extension is needed for "compelling academic or medical reasons." Academic probation or suspension do **not** constitute valid reasons for an extension.
