

## ART

- Studio Art score of 4 or 5 = 4 semester hours of Art; satisfies General Education Art & Music requirement
- Art History score of 4 or 5 = 4 semester hours of Art History credit (Art majors see department chair); satisfies General Education Art & Music requirement

## BUSINESS

- Statistics score of 4 or 5 = 4 semester hours of Statistics credit through the Business & Economics Department

## ENGLISH

- English Language and Composition score of 4 or 5 = 3 semester hours of Writing in the Liberal Arts; satisfies General Education Writing 101 requirement
- English Literature and Composition score of 4 or 5 = 3 semester hours of Writing in the Liberal Arts\*; satisfies General Education Writing 101 requirement

## \*ENGLISH AND HISTORY

- English Literature and Composition score of 4 or 5 **AND** World History score of 4 or 5 = 3 semester hours of HUM 101; satisfies one course in General Education Humanities
- English Literature and Composition score of 4 or 5 **AND** European History score of 4 or 5 = 3 semester hours of HUM 102 or HUM 201; satisfies one course in General Education Humanities

## HISTORY

- American History score of 4 or 5 = 3 semester hours of elective credit (non-major)
  - European History\* score of 4 or 5 = 3 semester hours of elective credit (non-major)
  - World History\* score of 4 or 5 = 3 semester hours of elective credit (non-major)
- If an AP History course is used to obtain credit for HUM 101, HUM 102, or HUM 201, the credit will shift from 3 hours of general elective credit to 3 hours of HUM 101, HUM 102, or HUM 201 credit.*

## LANGUAGE

- Language score of 4 or 5 = 3 semester hours of intermediate foreign language; satisfies one course in General Education Changing World requirement
- Language literature score of 4 or 5 = 3 semester hours of language literature; satisfies one course in General Education Changing World requirement

## MUSIC

- Music Theory score of 4 or 5 = 4 semester hours of MTH 220 Music Theory I (3) and MTH 221 Musicianship I (1); satisfies General Education Art & Music requirement

## SCIENCE AND MATH

- Biology score of 5 = 8 semester hours of General Biology
- Biology score of 4 = 4 hours of General Biology I or II (If pursuing a major in Biology, consult department chair)
- Calculus AB score of 4 or 5 = 4 semester hours of Calculus I; satisfies General Education Mathematics requirement
- Calculus BC score of 4 or 5 = 4 semester hours of Calculus I and 4 semester hours of Calculus II; satisfies General Education Mathematics requirement
- Chemistry score of 4 = 4 semester hours of non-major lab science credit

- Chemistry score of 5 = 4 semester hours of General Chemistry I (CHEM 151)
- Computer Science AB score of 4 or 5 = 4 semester hours of elective credit in Computer Science
- Environmental Science score of 4 or 5 = 4 semester hours of Environmental Earth Science or non-major lab science
- Physics 1 and 2 score of 5 = 4 semester hours of General Physics I (PHYS 151)
- Physics score of 4 = 4 semester hours of non-major lab science credit
- Physics B score of 5 = 4 semester hours of General Physics I (PHYS 151)
- Physics C/Mechanics score of 4 or 5 = General Physics I (PHYS 151)
- Physics C/Mechanics score of 4 or 5 and AP Physics C/Electricity & Magnetism score of 5 = Gen Physics I and II (8 hrs)

#### SOCIAL SCIENCES

- Economics Micro or Macro score of 4 or 5 = 3 semester hours of micro- or macroeconomics
- Government score of 4 or 5 = 3 semester hours; satisfies one course of the General Education Social Science requirement
- Human Geography score of 4 or 5 = 3 semester hours of general elective credit
- Psychology score of 4 or 5 = 3 semester hours of Introduction to Psychology (PSY 111); satisfies one course of the General Education Social Science requirement

#### OTHER

- Statistics score of 4 or 5 = 4 semester hours of general elective credit (if not a business or accounting major)

Occasionally, department chairs evaluate AP scores in other areas. Three or four semester hours of college credit are typically granted for scores of 4 or 5.
