Important Facility/Show Guidelines:

- Starting with class 9, the Low & Slow division, through the rest of the divisions; in order to enter a flat class, the horse (for hunter divisions) or rider (for equitation divisions) **MUST** enter the over fences classes as well. Competitors wishing to ride in just flat classes should register to ride in classes 1-8.
- Riders may only enter classes over poles/fences that are within 3 heights of each other.
 - Ex. Those entering in cross rails are able to also compete in ground poles and 2', but are not allowed to go beyond that into other heights.
- In the event of a tie for a division, medals will be awarded for the rider with higher point in the over fences class

Show Costs:

- **Class Fees:** \$10/class, Jumper Jackpot is an additional \$10 (\$20 total)
- **Office Fee:** \$10 for show day registration, \$5 if registration & payment is mailed in and postmarked by April 23rd. Payments mailed in won't be processed until show weekend. Checks can be made out to Houghton College and mailed to . . .

DIVISIONS

EQUITATION divisions are judged on the RIDER'S form, tact, accuracy, and ability to control the horse.

HUNTER divisions are judged on the HORSE'S quality of movement and jumping, manners, and obedience.

WALK-TROT/WALK-TROT-CANTER EQUITATION Open to riders of any age, limited to this division. Riders may not enter any other divisions above ground poles.

WALK-TROT/WALK-TROT-CANTER HUNTER Open to horses ridden by a Walk-Trot or Walk-Trot-Canter Equitation Rider only. Horses judged on manners, obedience, accuracy and gaits suitable for carrying a walk-trot/canter rider.

HUNTER UNDER SADDLE Open to all horses and ponies. Hunter Under Saddle class judged at the walk, trot and canter. All classes in this division are run as group classes. Judged on way of going and manners.

SHORT/LONG STIRRUPS EQUITATION Open to all age riders. One class over cross rails courses, judged individually, one group flat equitation class. Riders may also enter Hunter Under Saddle and Low & Slow Hunter divisions.

LOW & SLOW HUNTER Open to horses ridden in Hunter Under Saddle, and any equitation division with fences 2' and under in height. One class over a course of cross rails judged individually and one under saddle class judged as a group.

CHILDREN'S/ADULT HUNTER Open to horses and ponies ridden by any age rider, may also be ridden in any equitation division with fences 2'3" and under. Also open to horses eligible for Baby Green Hunter Division.

BEGINNER EQUITATION Open to all riders in their first year of showing over 2'3" courses. One class over 2'3" course, judged individually and one flat equitation class judged as a group.

BABY GREEN HUNTER Open to horses and ponies in their first year of showing over 2'3" courses. One class over fences, judged individually, and one under saddle class judged as a group.

JUNIOR/ADULT HUNTER Open to all horses and ponies except those from the LOW & SLOW HUNTER or the CHILDREN'S/ADULT HUNTER divisions. One class over 2'6" fences judged individually, one under saddle class judged as a group.

OPEN EQUITATION Open to any age rider not competing in a lower equitation division under 2'3". One course over 2'6" fences, one flat class.

JUNIOR/ADULT ADVANCED HUNTER Open to all horses and ponies except those from classes/divisions below 2'3" in height. One class over 2'9" fences judged individually, one under saddle class judged as a group.

ADVANCED EQUITATION Open to any age rider not competing in a lower equitation division under 2'6". One courses over 2'9" fences, one flat class.

Starting with class 9, the LOW & SLOW division through the rest of the divisions; in order to enter a flat class, the horse (for hunter divisions) or rider (for equitation divisions) MUST enter the over fences classes as well. Competitors wishing to ride in flat classes only are directed to ride in classes 1-8.

JUMPER Jumpers are judged solely on their ability to jump clean, on course, and within the allowed time.

Table II Section 1 = "The first round is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. Horses with clear rounds or equal faults are classified according to their time taken to complete the course." *USEF 2022 Jumper Division Rulebook*

Table II Section 2B = The first round and first jump-off, if any, are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. If a competitor has gone clear in the first round, the competitor will, without leaving the ring, upon an audible signal, commence the designated jump-off course. A competitor with a clear round may dismount, and with assistance if necessary, adjust tack and/or equipment; however, upon the audible signal to begin his/her round, the competitor is responsible to adhering to the 45 seconds rule as per JP137.3. In case of a fall of a Rider and/or Horse after crossing the finish line of the first round, the Rider/Horse combination may not continue to the jump-off, and will be placed according to their Score in the first round. A competitor who leaves the arena after a clear round (before or after the tone) will be considered to have withdrawn from the jump-off (exception JP138.1). If there are no clear rounds and a tie exists for first place, the results will be determined by the scores and time from that round. It is recommended that no more than twelve numbered obstacles be included in the first round when the class is scored under this table. *USEF 2022 Jumper Division Rule Book*

Power and Speed = Rider must go clear over the first 5 to 6 fences, if they are clear then their time starts after fence 5 or 6 and time and faults count for the remaining fences in the course. Course will consist of 10-12 fences.
