Description:

Houghton College invites applications for a part-time, adjunct appointment or a full-time, visiting appointment in the Department of Biology starting in the Fall 2022 semester.

Responsibilities include teaching general education, freshman, and/or sophomore level biology classes, as determined by candidate expertise, interest, and experience and departmental needs. Specific teaching load will be determined at the time of hire but may include courses such as general biology lecture and/or lab, ecology, and genetics. Individuals employed on a full-time basis are additionally expected to actively participate in departmental and area initiatives.

Qualifications:

Required qualifications include a master's degree in biology or a closely related field by the beginning of the appointment. Also required are the ability to help students form respectful attitudes and interactions with people who differ in abilities, attitudes, and cultural experience, with sensitivity to factors that affect our own assessment of others; excellent interpersonal and communication skills; a commitment to excellence and creativity in undergraduate teaching; and a mature Christian faith with the desire to integrate Christian faith into teaching.

Preferred qualifications include a terminal degree in biology or a closely related field and experience teaching at the undergraduate level.

For priority consideration, please submit all application materials by July 15, 2022. Screening of applicants will begin immediately and continue until position is filled.
