



## GRADUATION HONORS

Latin honors are awarded for bachelor-level degrees only. The faculty will select for Latin honors undergraduate students of outstanding scholarship. Beginning with Commencement of 2010, a student must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.5 for the recognition of cum laude, at least 3.7 for magna cum laude, and at least 3.9 for summa cum laude. Students transferring from other colleges must complete 62 hours at Houghton University to be eligible for Latin honors. Latin honors as published in the May Commencement bulletin are based on the cumulative GPA at the end of the fall semester prior to Commencement, including the valedictorian and salutatorian. To be eligible to be valedictorian or salutatorian, a student must be a main campus student, full-time in the spring, and a May graduate and must have earned a minimum of 90 Houghton University credits.
