NOTES:

- No more than 8 credit hours of Applied Music may count toward graduation for students who are not majoring or minoring in Music.
- No more than 8 credits of Horsemanship may count toward graduation unless the student is a SRWM major with an Equestrian emphasis or is pursuing an Equestrian Studies minor.
- No more than 8 credits of ROTC or Theatre Workshop may count toward graduation unless the student is pursuing a Military Leadership minor.
 - Examples regarding the restrictions above: A student earning 12 Horsemanship credits will need <u>128</u> total credits in order to graduate unless majoring in SRWM Equestrian Emphasis or minoring in Equestrian; OR a student earning 10 credits with ROTC will need <u>126</u> total credits in order to graduate.
- Students must have 62 earned hours from HU to receive graduation honors. In order to be eligible to be valedictorian or salutatorian, they must be May grads, full time in the Spring semester, and have earned a minimum of 90 HU credits.
